ACTIVITY THREE

DEFORESTATION IS A MAJOR ISSUE IN COTE D'IVOIRE AND GHANA, WHICH TOGETHER PRODUCE NEARLY TWO-THIRDS OF THE WORLD'S SUPPLY OF COCOA. COTE D'IVOIRE AND GHANA RESPECTIVELY LOST 25% AND 8% OF THEIR PRIMARY FOREST BETWEEN 2002-2019, WITH A SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF DEFORESTATION DUE TO COCOA FARMING. AT THE NOVEMBER 2017 UN CLIMATE CHANGE CONFERENCE (COP23), THE GOVERNMENTS OF COTE D'IVOIRE AND GHANA AND LEADING CHOCOLATE AND COCOA COMPANIES SIGNED THE COCOA & FORESTS INITIATIVE FRAMEWORKS FOR ACTION. IN MARCH 2019, ANOTHER MILESTONE WAS REACHED TO STRENGTHEN TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY IN THE COCOA SUPPLY CHAIN: THE SIGNATORIES RELEASED ACTION PLANS THAT SPELL OUT CONCRETE STEPS TO END COCOA-RELATED DEFORESTATION. THE ACTION PLANS FOCUS ON: FOREST PROTECTION AND RESTORATION, SUSTAINABLE COCOA PRODUCTION AND FARMERS' LIVELIHOODS, COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND SOCIAL INCLUSION. IN 2020, THE COCOA & FORESTS INITIATIVE REPORTED ON THE FIRST TWO YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION.
